Sports Academy Consent and Agreement

Representing the College in the Sports Academy is a privilege students must earn through their ability, effort and attitude. Students are expected to represent the College with pride, uphold high standards of fair play, be aware of and follow safety guidelines at all times, and demonstrate behaviours outlined in the College's <u>Representative Eligibility Policy</u> (REP), which is available on the College website.

REP outlines minimum expectations for attendance, behaviour and finance for students and parents/carers, which are:

- Attendance: 90% actual attendance; less than 10% unacceptable or unexplained reasons for lateness to school.
- **Behaviour:** Over the previous four weeks, students must adhere to the BPC behaviour expectations; consistently display a high standard of behaviour in class, in the school grounds, on excursions and in the community; no incidents resulting in a red or yellow behaviour monitoring card or suspension; no incidents of truancy; Year 11/12 only, submit final copies of assessment pieces on time and attend all scheduled exam/s and catch-up block/s.
- **Finance:** Student Resource Scheme (SRS) deposit paid \$75 per student; active payment plan/Centrepay deduction in place for all owed outstanding fees.

Consequences for non-compliance with REP:

- Students may be withdrawn from games or program of events for a period of time.
- Students may be removed from the Sports Academy.
- Students may be issued with other consequences in accordance with the Responsible Behaviour plan for Students.

Students and their parent/carer must complete the **Sports Academy Consent and Agreement**, acknowledging they have read and understood information regarding the Sports Academy, including REP.
